3 **Communication and Media**

Judy Venables raised the subject of what the public know about the CDRP. Should Test Valley Partnership have a strategy?

Brian Cowcher (BC) explained that the website is being developed and looked at after a recommendations raised by the Audit Commission.

GT- Raised this at LSP level with James moody for whole partnership and not just CDRP

Jason Avery (JA) suggested using events such as the Fire Service Open Day or the Romsey Show to highlight CDRP activity might be a way of promoting what the CDRP do.

Cllr Nigel Anderdon has requested a short report to Parish Councils would be useful on community safety work being undertaken by CDRP.

Action- James Moody will take lead via the LSP route on this to ensure a Partnership approach

4 **Schedule of Events**

A calendar of Events for the forthcoming year is being put together for all partners to contribute to

JA asked that Open Days be included into the calendar and Neil Lockett suggested using these to also promote health issues such as smoking. All agreed Open days are a potentially good opportunity to promote partnership working

.Action: GT to look at this possibly with a view to promoting partnership working via the Romsey show on the 2nd Saturday of September- The contact at Hampshire County is Gary Kerlake

5 **Neighbourhood Management**

GT reported that a meeting involving Police, Test Valley, Fire and County Council representatives to look at boundaries and operational resources took place recently. Agreed for need to join up more to ensure that hose resources are maximised to a greater effect.

The Joint Action Group (JAG) will explore this further and the next stage will be to extend this out further to include other agencies such as Housing Associations and Voluntary Sector

5B **Performance Management**

GT- Explained that there has been a small delay with Business Objects, but still has IQuanta data to highlight trends. End of year crime shows a 7% fall on all crime. BCS data crime is 11% down in comparison with previous year.

Cllr Perry suggested it would be good to know the reasons for this success, Garry explained that the IQuanta stats would be difficult to share but would be able to share some IQuanta data if Business Objects is not fully up and running by the next meeting.
