3 Street Pastors: Rev. Colin James

Rev. Colin James gave a presentation to the board on the Street Pastor project. The Street Pastor scheme is an inter-denominational Church response to Urban problems. The aim of the scheme is to engage with people (especially the young) where they are, in terms of their thinking (their perspective of life) and location (where they frequent – be it on the streets, in the pubs and clubs or at parties). A

Street Pastor scheme is due to be implemented in Test Valley later this year: recruiting and training is taking place over the Summer with the aim of having 16 Street Pastors in place by Christmas 2010.

7 Chairman's Update

- **County Strategy Group (8 Jun 10):**
 - **Domestic Abuse** - 2 websites launched: one for professionals and one for the public; training packages developed; work ongoing with regard to DA and vulnerable adults. County-wide IDVA service, commissioning has been delayed to April 2011
 - **Crime Analysis** - Pre analysed reports and joint strategic assessments will be piloted by Central OCU
 - **IOM** - Likely to start in April 2011; funds held over to be passported to CSPs to cover period Nov 10-Mar 11.
 - **Alcohol Service** - HOMER (Hants operating Module for Effective Recovery) service due to go live in Apr 11; pharmacy-based interventions going well and seen as "best practice".
 - **Public Confidence Review** – sub-group have produced a list of actions that CSPs can dip into for local implementation. **Action:** Agreed that Delivery Group should review this; Judy to pass document to Brian.
 - **Funding Update** - Details of reduction not yet clear in relation to the Area Based Grant. Much will depend on the budget outcome on the 22nd June 2010
