3.	<p><b>Matters Arising</b></p> <p><b>Item 3 ACTION:</b> Jantocontact Portsmouth and Southampton Universities re: Family Learning foundation degree – no further information.</p> <p><b>Item 4</b> ACLU have submitted an expression of interest to the Big Lottery worth £500,000 over 2 years. If successful funding would go to all 11 Hampshire districts pro-rata but targeting communities with family learning need.</p> <p>HCC Recreation and Heritage have also submitted an expression of interest to Big Lottery worth £304,600 over 3 years for Gosport and Havant but utilising Andover Family Learning to provide the expertise on how to engage people. AFL would benefit from funding for staff.</p>

<p>6.</p>	<p><b>Charitable Status for Test Valley Family Learning</b></p> <p>A number of options were discussed including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• seeking charitable status</li> <li>• seeking funding from TVBC</li> <li>• seeking funding from charities such as Esmée Fairbairn etc</li> <li>• using TVCS in connection with Turnaround Project, as a sub contract to brella</li> <li>• using a future King Arthur's Way Community Association to subcontract delivery to AFL.</li> <li>• using Transform (the charity arm of Testway Housing) to bid for funds and subcontract delivery to AFL.</li> </ul> <p>Following discussion it was agreed that the last option held greatest potential on the basis that Testway was experienced in this kind of work, family learning would benefit its tenants most and Test way are the heart of the Turnaround Project etc.</p> <p><b>AGREED:</b> CG to approach Steve Benson at Testway with a view to raising the idea at the forthcoming Test Valley Partnership Group on 8 December 2006.</p>
