Rob reported that for the TAP Project, 2 Health Trailers have set up a pilot in the Alamein Ward, funding will be covered until June 07 and future funding will be looked at by the PCT if it proves to be a success. The Group were supportive of the scheme.

It was suggested that Steve Garnett (Adult Services) should also be invited to the Group and also someone from Childrens Services. ie Lynn Penny. Although it was suggested that the Action Plan is completed and agreed by the Group before hand.

Ange Moon from CAB has asked that she is taken off the mailing list for the Group as she is unable to attend meetings at present.

Ocean FM Radio Station are running an advertising campaign with 100 day countdown to England going smoke free. It is anticipated that there will be an increase of 50% in demand for quitting services.

Most sexual health work is ongoing at present. Rob is keen to recruit more Andover pharmacists to join the Emergency Contraception Scheme and is presently working on this.
