	<p>Romsey is concerned that HCC's decision to have just one team based in Andover rather than two could pose problems for southern Test Valley being referred under the Common Assessment Framework (CAF).</p> <p>The meeting discussed the uncertainty of how the roles of completers and professional leaders is being interpreted by schools but other agencies e.g. the Police are not going to complete CAFs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Extended Services Update Andover Area (incl. Stockbridge) (CG)</b>            A Partnership Steering Group has been formed representing all schools, the Andover Education Centre, partner organisations (e.g. TVBC, PCT, Youth Service), has been formed.         </li> </ul> <p>CG is standing in as Co-ordinator for the Autumn Term because Jean Lannie, is off sick. Harrow Way CS is the lead body to draw down the funding: £46,800 for capacity building/pump priming.</p> <p><b>Romsey Area (JL)</b>            The steering group will be set up with charitable status, limited by guarantee so it can bid for other money. It has a budget of £18,000 and will help Primary Schools in bids for Awards.</p> <p>The annual Family Learning event will take place in October 2007, a website is up and running; a Christmas newspaper will be sent out and school sites will create their own allotments.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Family Learning (CG, BJ)</b>            HCC will fund Harrow Way CS, Romsey School and Mountbatten at the same level in 2007/08 as in the current year.
