3 Alcohol Arrest Referral project

The Andover Alcohol Arrest Referral Project has been recently set up as a pilot to target hazardous drinkers. The first (and to date only) one of its kind in Hampshire, it will provide a form of 'brief intervention', starting at the point of custody and carried out over three sessions. It targets 'hazardous' drinkers and employs a 0.5 fte who will have the capacity to see 5 clients per day on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. The pilot will last for 6 months and they expect a throughput of around 200 clients. An evaluation will take place at the end of the project.

4 Alcohol Control Zones

The Partnership's JAG has identified hot spots of crime and antisocial behaviour linked to drinking in public places. It has recommended that TVBC considers extending the existing **Alcohol Control Zone** to Romsey (Abbey, Cupernham, Tadburn) Romsey Extra, North Baddesley, Valley Park, Chilworth, Nursling & Rownhams, Andover (Alamein, Harroway, Millway, Winton, St Mary's) Charlton. This proposal will be considered by TVBC Cabinet on 16th October 2007.

5 Partnership Performance Report

1) Report A) Full October Report

No. of crimes increased from Feb 06 to Oct 06 but has since decreased, although results continue to suggest we are unlikely to hit targets.

2) Report B) March 2007 KPI snapshot

Quant data suggest a large gap between targets and performance.

3) Report C) October 2007 KPI snapshot

Quant data suggest a demonstrable improvement over the March '07 figures, although current indicators suggest that targets are unlikely to be hit by April '08.

4) Delivery group performance report

The report indicates that around half of targets are 'green' while the other half are 'amber' or 'red'.

6 Weeks of Action – CREW+

The recent CREW+ took place at King Arthur's Way and Anton Lakes Nature Reserve between 17-23 September and focused on **Environment, Antisocial Behaviour and Community Development**. There were a range of achievements including the removal of fly tipping, environmental improvements and a series of activities for the community to get involved. The team feel the event was a great success but acknowledge the need to improve on community engagement.

7 County co-ordinating body and strategic assessments

The work on the **strategic assessments** is continuing. The **County Coordinating Group** recently held its first meeting to determine its terms of reference. There is a demand for leadership at County level to get the group up and running as well as an awareness that there also need to be a 'bottom up' approach at local level.
