3 Partnership Performance Report

a) iQuanta Report

Rather than reducing the BCS crime comparator figure by 17% the figure has risen by 17% over the last 3 years.

Extra support has been put in place to include:

- Additional ACSO patrols
- Further £6k of funding from GOSE to support action before the end of the financial year.

b) FTAP Delivery Report – Floor Target Action Plan

- Actions mainly on target though overall performance is still below target
- Warden have been accredited by Hampshire Constabulary. This gives them increased power to deal with drinking in public places.
- An evaluation of the recent CREW has been published on the website
- £15k was raised in the meeting to extend AMEC. The project is currently being evaluated and there will be a report available from 14th Feb. Further publicity is being arranged. The PCT are interested in building on the project to make it countywide and is hoping to secure commitment from partners.
- TVBC have agreed to extend designated public order areas – feedback has been positive so far and provided all goes well they will be implemented in April.
- MARAC is up and running.
- An IDVA has been appointed – this is a shared post with Basingstoke and Deane. This is a 15ph post and as such can only take on those at highest risk. The appointee, Emma Sanders will be located in Basingstoke and Andover.
- YISP has been extended to cover the whole of the Borough. Key features include:
 - Targets 8-13 year olds at risk of ASB
 - Groupwork on a weekly basis with young people
 - 3.5 FTEs

- Carry out diversionary activities at weekends and holidays
- Young people involved in CREW weeks
- 13 members of staff in total
- A new computer system will be installed over the next two months

4 Finance Report

Partners are not yet sure they will be able to maintain contributions at this year's level.

Some projects may be commissioned at County level, including YISP.

5 Strategic Assessment and Priorities Report

Priorities for the Partnership are:
