## 3 Partnership Performance Report

Garry Tallett: I quant does not provide appropriate detail to monitor partnership performance. Two models being looked at by Hants CC (i) Business Objects (ii) Yorkshire Police Model. One of these systems will be adopted by County and proposed we apply the same system. All agreed and proposed that all Districts apply the same model

Chief Inspector Martin Jeffery provided an extract from Business Objects which showed the type of data that can highlight the Partnership Performance. James Moody highlighted that Test Valley are adopting a performance management system and that there should be some correlation between the two

Overall message is that Test Valley is a safe place to live, there are some different types of crimes between Andover, Rural and Romsey but there has been a general reduction in crime in Test Valley

## 4 County Strategy Group

Carol Rooke- Reported that the means are in place to set up an agreement around commissioning. Carol and Sandra attended an event in Netley which looked at aligning the Criminal Justice Board and CDRP and reported that there is some positive progress.

Cllr Perry endorsed this progress highlighting collective benefits in Districts working on similar themes to help efficiency but at the same time being able to still focus on local priorities.

## 5 Meeting the new Partnership Standard

Garry Tallett- talked through the document which both he and Martin had worked through. The document highlights areas which need some attention, such as attendance from PCT at CDRP meetings, terms of reference for the group and the need to hold public meetings once a year. Suggested that all look at the document and highlight any gaps and feedback to Garry and Martin. Garry and James are looking at Milton Keynes which has been flagged up by

GOSE as an example of Best Practice'.

Garry also highlighted a Hants Community Safety Project Mapping document which shows what Districts are doing. All to have a look at and highlight any projects which need to be added against Test Valley and advise Garry accordingly.

## 6 Partnership Manager Introduction - James Moody

James provided an overview of LSP and the Partnership

Some of the main themes include;

Guidance for LSPs, priorities, shared vision, viewing an impact d managing progress,

There are eight action groups of which community safety is one.

Will be looking at how we deliver against joint priorities and how we can work closely together.
