NUTS codes

NUTS (Nomenclature of Units for Territorial Statistics) is a hierarchical classification of spatial units that provides a breakdown of the European Union's territory for producing regional statistics which are comparable across the EU. NUTS4 is comparable with Local Authorities and NUTS3 is broadly comparable to Counties or equivalent in the UK. The NUTS 4 areas in Scotland do not match exactly the Scottish Local Authority Areas therefore a lookup to NUTS3 areas cannot be given.
