## Deprivation Domains (37 indicators)

Original 6 Domains are now 7: Living Environment and Crime are new but Geographic Access to Services has been merged with Housing Need!

## Income Deprivation

- Adults and children on Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Working Families Tax Credit, Disabled Persons Tax Credit and households using the National Asylum Support Services.

## Employment Deprivation – “the involuntary exclusion from the work”

- Unemployment count, Incapacity Benefit claimants Severe Disablement Allowance, Participants in New Deal.

## Health Deprivation – “relatively high rates of premature death or whose quality of life is impaired”

- Mortality, Comparative illness, emergency admissions to hospitals.

## Education, Skills and Training

- Attainment by children and level of qualifications (skills).

## Barriers to Housing - “combines geographic and wider barriers to housing”

- Overcrowding, difficulty gaining access to owner occupation.
- Distance by road to GP, local shop, primary school, P.O.

## Living Environment

- **Indoors – quality of housing.**
- **Outdoors – air quality, road traffic accidents.**

## Crime

- **Rate of recorded crime (burglary, theft, criminal damage and violence).**

Lowest Middle Best quartile

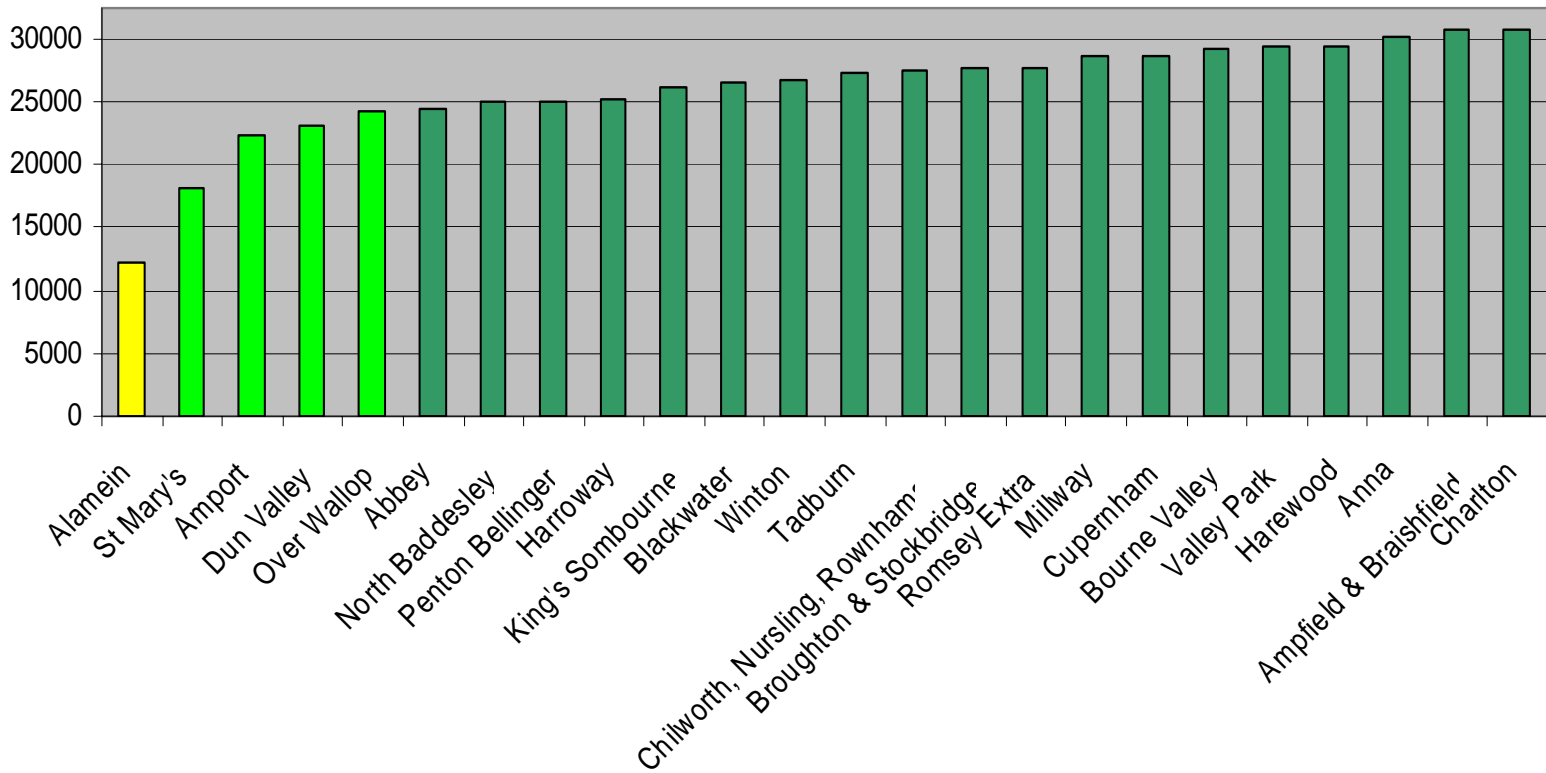


# IMD 2004 – national rank comparison
